



# A Note from Pastor Blake

Dear WBC Family,

Every December, we remember that Christmas is the story of God sending His Son into the world. But have you ever paused to consider that the story of Christmas began long before Christmas?

Before there was a manger, before there were shepherds, wise men, or angels singing, God had already set His mission in motion. His mission? To fill the earth with His glory by redeeming a people from every nation.

That's what we're focusing on in our new sermon series, "The Mission of God." Over the next four Sundays, we'll walk together from Genesis to Galatians, seeing how God's plan for the nations—from Eden to Abraham to the prophets—finds its ultimate expression in the coming of Christ.

## **From the Garden to the Manger**

### **December 1 — Created for Mission**

Genesis shows us that humanity was created in the image of God to *fill the earth* with His glory. Sin, however, would threaten that mission. From the moment Adam and Eve fell, the world has been longing for a Redeemer—the promised Seed who would crush the serpent and restore what was broken. Christmas is God keeping that promise.

### **December 8 — Blessed to Be a Blessing**

While I'm away in Oaxaca, MX, Kevin Kilby will lead us through Genesis 12 and God's call to Abram. Long before Jesus came, God promised that through Abraham's offspring "all the nations of the earth would be blessed." That blessing finds its ultimate fulfillment in Christ.

### **December 15 — A Light to the Nations**

Through the prophets, God revealed that His Servant would not only restore Israel but would bring salvation "to the ends of the earth." That Servant is Jesus—the Light who dawned in Bethlehem to pierce the darkness for every tribe, tongue, and people.

### **December 22 — Sent in the Fullness of Time**

And on the final Sunday before Christmas, we'll rejoice in Galatians 4:4-5: "When the fullness of time had come, God sent forth His Son..." The mission begun in Eden and promised to Abraham finds its crescendo in the coming of Christ. God sent his Son to redeem sinners and adopt us into God's worldwide family.

The Christmas story is a missionary story.





## Oaxaca

And just as God has always been pursuing the nations, our church has the privilege of joining Him in that mission. From December 2–10, I will be traveling with pastors from:

- Pleasant Hill Baptist Church
- Place of Prayer
- Jessup Grove Baptist Church

In addition, we're partnering in prayer and future mission work with:

- Simmons Grove Baptist Church
- Fellowship Missionary Baptist Church

Together, we'll be asking God how our churches can most effectively serve among some of the most lost communities in Mexico.

Our goal is simple: to seek clarity and conviction.  
Clarity about *where* God would have us work.  
Conviction about *how* He would have us join Him.

We'll be visiting villages on mountains and in jungles. We'll be in places where gospel access is limited. Churches are few and sparse. The spiritual need is great.

Please pray:

1. For Discernment — that God would show us clearly which communities to invest in.
2. For Relationships — that our time with local pastors and missionaries would bear fruit.
3. For Opportunity — that open doors will be made obvious, even in difficult-to-reach places.
4. For Protection — as we travel through remote and rugged regions.
5. For Unity — that these five partnering churches would work shoulder to shoulder for Christ.

## A Final Word

When you see a Christmas tree this year, remember: the story of Christmas is the story of mission. When you hear the angels' song, remember: their praise anticipates the worldwide worship God promised to Abraham.

When you look at the manger, remember this: the Child born in Bethlehem is the Savior God promised in Eden. He is the Light Isaiah foretold. He is the Redeemer who is gathering distant nations into His family.

May we joyfully take part in the mission that began before time, is fulfilled in Christ, and will one day be completed when all nations worship at His feet.




