The offering was started in 1895 by Woman's Missionary Union® (WMU) to benefit the work of the Home Mission Board (now North American Mission Board). In 1934, it was named in honor of Annie Armstrong, a bold missions advocate and WMU's first national executive leader. Today, more than \$2 billion has been donated by Southern Baptist churches and individuals to support thousands of missionaries in church planting and compassion ministries. Because of this sacrificial giving, millions of lives have been and continue to be transformed by the power of the gospel. ¹

From My Heart,

In a devotional I was reading — I came across something powerful. It said, 'For far too many Christians, the story of Easter has become just another day on a busy calendar. They know all the facts: Jesus was arrested, He was crucified, His lifeless body was placed in a borrowed tomb and three days later - God raised Him from the dead. We miss something very important — the story of Christ's Resurrection isn't just His Story...but our story as well!'

Christ's Resurrection doesn't just prove He experienced LIFE after DEATH...it proves WE can have LIFE after DEATH! There is LIFE beyond the grave. For all who have placed their FAITH in the RISEN CHRIST — DEATH is merely a transition...never an ending point! Amos Traver once said, 'Death is not a period, but a comma in the story of life for the believer.'

Jesus told Martha in John 11:25-26: 'I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in Me, though he die, yet shall he live, and everyone who lives and believes in Me shall never die.' That's quite a promise! The Bible says in 1 Corinthians 6:14: 'And God will raise us from the dead by His power, just as He raised our Lord from the dead.'

Max Lucado puts it this way, 'God did His greatest work when He spoke to the dead body of His Son - with Hell's demons and Heaven's angels watching - He called on the Rose of Sharon to lift His head; The Lion of Judah to stretch forth His paw; The Bright and Morning Star to shine forth His light; The Alpha and Omega, to be the beginning of life and the end of the grave...and JESUS DID!'

This year, as we prepare to celebrate Easter, this is a truth we can all hang our lives upon. It's great news that God raised Jesus from the dead, but what turns this story into living color is one day, for all who've placed their faith in Him – He will RAISE US from the GRAVE, too!! This is the **PROMISE of EASTER!!**
