


Special Offering for the month of February

A passage I've grown to treasure is Nehemiah 8:10 – 'The joy of the Lord is your strength.' Do you find yourself needing to be reminded of this TRUTH? The better they know the plays, the more confident they can execute their position. God has given us HIS Word to give us confidence in carrying out HIS mission through our daily lives. Check out I Peter 3:15.

Third, **be READY and WILLING**. In the film, Rudy, you saw a young man who lived with his hand in the air — **'Put me in the game, Coach!**' He made up for his lack of size and talent by his determination to play for Notre Dame. If you remember, Rudy didn't ride the bench during games — he stayed under the coach's feet, so he could hear his name when it was called. When asked if he was ready to play, he replied — **'I've been ready for this my whole life.'** Check out Colossians 3:23.

Fourth, don't HESITATE to SPEAK UP! When others around you ask, 'What is it that makes you tick?' TELL THEM. Always be willing to testify to ALL the many wonderful things the LORD has done for YOU!! Check out Romans 1:16.

Finally, **always be ALL IN**. I hope you're not like some players who are simply satisfied to 'make the team and enjoy the benefits'. If you're going to play, then let's be ALL IN!! I can assure you, there will be plenty of people who'll listen, if you're ready to give the Lord all the glory! Check out I Corinthians 10:31, Philippians 3:13-14 and 2 Timothy 4:7.

If we're going to put on the uniform (the character of Christ), then let's step up and BE the kind of player God has called us to BE!! Everyone is known for something; may we be known as faithfully following Christ and being fully devoted to HIM!!

Please continue to keep our Pastor Search Team in your prayers as they are discerning 'who' God is calling to serve as your next Pastor. 




