Hi Church Family,

It's been 10 years since I started attending Westfield Baptist Church on a regular basis and it's been 9 years since I started working at WBC. What started off as a small 5 hour a week, website administrator role has now turned into a full time dual role. I never imagined when I married Brandon that God would lead me to begin working at Westfield Baptist Church. In those 10 years, we, as a church have seen a lot of transition. It hasn't always been easy, but I feel like God has taught me so very valuable lessons during that time. One major lesson that I have learned is to keep your focus on God and trust His plans. Life can be full of distractions. Sometimes those distractions look like Pastors leaving, deaths in your family, career changes, family changes, or just the busy everyday life. All of these things will tempt you to lose sight of your personal relationship with God. However, when you focus on God, you will see that he is using all these changes for good. Romans 8:28 reminds us that "...all things work together for the good of those who love God, who have been called according to His purpose. That doesn't mean every season feels good. It doesn't mean we won't experience confusion, grief, or uncertainty. But it does mean that nothing is wasted. God uses the hard transitions to strengthen our faith. He uses loss to remind us where our true hope rests. He uses change to grow us in ways comfort never could. When our focus stays on Him, we are anchored. We may feel the waves of change, but we are not swept away by them. Trusting His plan means believing that even when we cannot see the full picture, He already does. And if we remain faithful and keep our eyes on Him, we will one day look back and see how His hand was guiding us through every step. In every season, steady or stormy, He is faithful. And learning to trust that has been one of the greatest lessons of all.

A second lesson that I have learned is to truly pray for all others. Usually when we think of praying for others we think of those who are close to us or we consider good friends. Which is such a powerful testament to friendship and the power of a praying friend. However, Jesus Matthew 5:44 tells us "But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you." Over the last few years, I secretly pick a person in my life that tends to have a negative effect on me and begin praying for them. I intentionally ask God to soften my heart towards this person and to show me ways that I can be a better sister in Christ to them. It has been one of the most impactful lessons in my life. I have learned how to truly humble myself and put the needs of others before myself. I would encourage you to begin doing the same. I truly believe that we as a church need to be better about praying for each other. We may not consider someone an enemy, but what if our attitudes towards each other were softer and kinder. What if we began praying for each other in a deep and meaningful way. I believe we would see some of the hurt begin to heal, we would see friendships begin to form, and hopefully we would see our church family truly become a healthy family.

The third and I think biggest lesson I have learned is to always remember that you are working for the Lord. Colossians 3:23 tells us "Whatever you do, do it from the heart, as something done for the Lord and not for people.". It's so easy to fall in the trap of crossing off our to-do list, working on projects around the church, and fulfilling our commitments to a committee that we forget that we are called to do all these things with our heart to honor God. When we remember who we are truly serving, it changes everything. It changes our attitude when the task feels small or unseen. It changes how we respond when someone disagrees with a decision or doesn't notice the effort behind the scenes. It reminds us that our reward is not praise, recognition, or even immediate results but faithfulness. Working for the Lord means we give our best even when no one is watching. It means we serve with joy, even in the ordinary and sometimes exhausting moments. It means that whether we are leading a Bible study, setting up chairs, answering emails, or simply listening to someone who needs to talk, we do it as an act of worship. When our focus stays on Him, the pressure to please people lessens. The frustration doesn't linger as long. And the work, no matter how routine, becomes sacred.

All of this to say, members of Westfield Baptist Church, I love you deeply. I'm here for you. We no doubt have another hard transition in front of us. Yet, I believe, if we stay focused on God, pray for each other, and continue to work for the Lord, we will survive and hopefully thrive.
