The Need, The Need, & The Need for Disciple-Making

Church family,

On March 5, I will give our second pastoral address, and my message will focus on one urgent reality: **we need to make disciples**. Consider this newsletter a prelude—a call to prepare our hearts and minds for what we will discuss in greater depth next month. This is not just an idea; it is a necessity. Our church's future, our obedience to Christ, and the eternal destiny of those around us all depend on it.

1. The Practical Need

Westfield Baptist Church is facing real, tangible struggles. Our attendance has declined over the past decade, and financial burdens weigh heavy. Our congregation is aging, and we must confront a sobering reality: unless we reach and disciple younger believers, our numbers will continue to dwindle. If we love this church and long to see it thrive for generations to come, we must commit ourselves to the work of discipleship.

2. The Biblical Need

Making disciples is not optional—it is commanded. Jesus' Great Commission in **Matthew 28:19-20** is clear: *"Go therefore and make disciples of all nations..."* This is not just a task for pastors or missionaries but for every believer. A church that does not disciple is a church that does not obey. If we love Christ, we must obey His command.

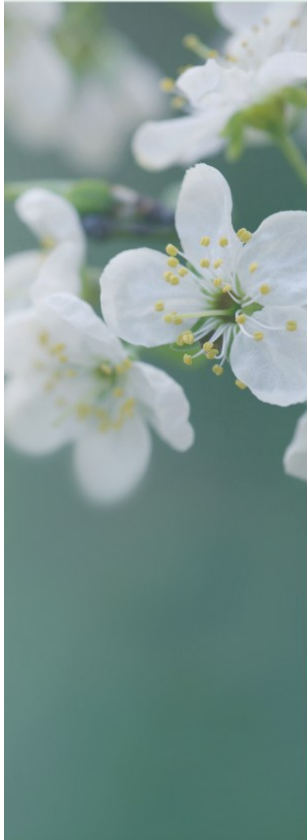
3. The Eternal Need

Perhaps the most urgent need of all: souls are perishing. Every day, people in our community slip into eternity without Christ. Hell is real. Judgment is real. The gospel is our only hope.
